With more than 100,000 visitors expected and over 350 tonnes of seafood, including 120 tonnes of prawns and almost 70,000 dozen oysters, to be sold, this year's marathon promises to be one for the history books as Sydneysiders bid farewell to the original site before the new Sydney Fish Market opens on 19 January 2026.

Sydneysiders will be able to shop for their favourite seafood around the clock, with doors open from 5:00am on Tuesday 23 December through to 5:00pm on Wednesday 24 December.

With over 100 different species available at the Market, there's something to suit every taste and budget. Alongside classic Christmas favourites like prawns, oysters, and Lobster, Sydney Fish Market's recommendations this year include Commercial Scallops, Coral Trout, Red Gurnard, and Octopus. Australia's home of seafood is ready to help hosts impress their guests with a showstopping, mouth-watering seafood spread this holiday season.

Limited car parking will be available at Sydney Fish Market, with additional parking at Sydney Secondary College Blackwattle Bay Campus (opposite Sydney Fish Market on Bridge Road).

Visitors commuting by public transport can catch the 501 and 389 bus services, which regularly depart from the city.
