Travel choices

Sydney Fish Market (SFM) is a leading tourist destination located in Blackwattle Bay in Sydney. Getting to the SFM is easy with a wide range of public transport, walking and bike riding options available.



Prioritise Public Transport

The easiest way to get to SFM is by public transport. SFM is conveniently located near several public transport routes including buses, light rail and trains.



Walk or ride to SFM

Walking or riding to SFM is convenient and easy with connections to local shared paths and bike routes. Check out the [City of Sydney Cycling Map](#) or [Trip Planner](#) to help you plan your trip.



Planning your journey

Use the [Trip Planner](#) to plan a trip on public transport by metro, train, bus, ferry, light rail, coach or by walking, cycling, taxi or rideshare anywhere in New South Wales.



Paying for your public transport is easier than ever

There are a range of options to pay for your travel on public transport, including credit/debit cards, digital wallets, and Opal cards. Simply tap on at the start and tap off at the end of your trip.

Getting to Sydney Fish Market using public transport

Public transport is the easiest way to get to SFM. Use the [Trip Planner](#) for detailed travel options and service times.



Light Rail

SFM is serviced by the L1 Dulwich Hill light rail line. Hop off at any of these stops:

- Wentworth Park stop is closest at 400m
- Glebe stop is 450m
- Bank Street stop is 700m.



Bus

SFM is serviced by two key bus routes on Harris Street (550m from SFM):

- Route 501: Parramatta to Central Pitt Street via Victoria Road & Pyrmont
- Route 389: Bondi Junction to Pyrmont.

Other bus routes nearby (Glebe Point Road, 750m or 10-minute walk) include:

- Route 370: Glebe Point to Coogee
- Route 431: Glebe Point to Martin Place
- Route 433: Balmain Gladstone to Central Pitt Street
- Route 469: Marketplace Leichardt via Glebe.



Train

- Central Station and Town Hall are the closest train stations, located approximately 2km from SFM.
- At Central Station you can change to L1 light rail services to Wentworth Park.




Metro

- Central Station and Gadigal Station are the closest metro stations, located approximately 2km from SFM.
- At Central Station you can change to L1 light rail services to Wentworth Park.

Walking and riding

There are plenty of options to include walking or bike riding as part of your journey to SFM.



Walking

- Walking is a great way to travel to SFM, with well-established footpaths to local attractions and public transport options.
- Safe pedestrian crossing points are provided across Bridge Road at the main entrance points.
- Fully accessible elevators and escalators are available within the SFM.
- Use [Trip Planner](#) to find walking routes for part or all of your journey to SFM.



Riding

- SFM is connected to local bike routes.
- [Trip Planner](#) lets you plan your bike riding route based on your skill level and preferences in three easy steps.
- Bike parking hoops are available on Bridge Road outside SFM.

Parking and drop off

SFM has parking and drop off options for those who need to drive.



- If you are planning to drive to SFM, consider car pooling to SFM with your friends, family or colleagues.
- Car parking is provided in the basement of SFM.
- Five drop off bays for taxis and ride share are at street level on Bridge Street.
- Visitor coach drop off zone is provided at street level on Bridge Street.
