Across Easter Saturday, Sunday and Monday, the Market opens from 7:00am to 10:00pm.

More than 100 seafood species will be available across the long weekend including Easter staples like prawns and oysters to seasonal standouts including Yellowtail Kingfish, Ocean Perch, Mullet and Gould's Squid. Across the Easter long weekend, approximately 650 tonnes of seafood is expected to be sold – including 100 tonnes of prawns and nearly one million oysters.
